1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 5 amended by changing Section 107-5 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/107-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 107-5)
- 7 Sec. 107-5. Method of arrest.
- 8 (a) An arrest is made by an actual restraint of the the person or by his submission to custody.
- 10 (b) An arrest may be made on any day and at any time of the day or night.
- 12 (c) An arrest may be made anywhere within the jurisdiction 13 of this State.
- (d) All necessary and reasonable force may be used to effect an entry into any building or property or part thereof to make an authorized arrest.
