Section 5. The Juvenile Court Act of 1987 is amended by
changing Section 4-1 as follows:

Sec. 4-1. Jurisdictional facts. Proceedings may be
instituted under <u>the</u> the provisions of this Article concerning

9 boys and girls who are addicted as defined in Section 4-3.
