2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2137 by replacing
3 lines 28 through 30 on page 1 and lines 1 through 3 on page 2
4 with the period the following:

5 "and any other information required by the Department.
6 Statements shall be filed with the Department by a contractor
7 at the beginning of each calendar year for independent
8 contractors performing work for the contractor at the beginning
9 of that calendar year. A contractor shall file statements with
10 the Department on April 1, July 1, and October 1 for any
11 additional independent contractors who began performing work
12 for the contractor during the 3-month period immediately
13 preceding the filing date. Contractors may file statements by
14 e-mail. The information obtained by"; and

15 on page 3, line 28 by inserting after the period the following:
16 "Any action by the Department directing a contractor to cease
17 its operations on a project may not take effect until the
18 contractor's administrative remedies have been exhausted.";
19 and

20 on page 3, line 33 by changing "Class 4 felony" to "Class A
21 misdemeanor".
