1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by
- 5 changing Section 1-106 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/1-106) (from Ch. 110, par. 1-106)
- 7 Sec. 1-106. Act to be liberally construed. This Act shall
- 8 be liberally construed, to $\underline{\text{the}}$ end that controversies may
- 9 be speedily and finally determined according to the substantive
- 10 rights of the parties. The rule that statutes in derogation of
- 11 the common law must be strictly construed does not apply to
- this Act or to the rules made in relation thereto.
