SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 130/25

Amends the Registered Surgical Assistant and Registered Surgical Technologist Title Protection Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the application for registration.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Registered Surgical Assistant and Registered Surgical Technologist Title Protection Act is
- 6 amended by changing Section 25 as follows:
- 7 (225 ILCS 130/25)
- 8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2014)
- Sec. 25. Application for registration. An application for an initial registration shall be made to the the Department in writing on forms prescribed by the Department and shall be accompanied by the required nonrefundable fee. An application shall require information that, in the judgment of the Department, will enable the Department to evaluate the
- 15 qualifications of an applicant for registration.
- If an applicant fails to obtain a certificate of registration under this Act within 3 years after filing his or her application, the application shall be denied. The applicant may make a new application, which shall be accompanied by the
- 20 required nonrefundable fee.
