1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
- 5 Division 15.2 to Article 11 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/Art. 11 Div. 15.2 heading new)
- 7 <u>DIVISION 15.2. ANNEXATION; DRAINAGE DISTRICTS</u>
- 8 (65 ILCS 5/11-15.2-1 new)
- 9 Sec. 11-15.2-1. If authorized by an agreement approved by
- the court pursuant to notice as required by Section 4-22 of the
- 11 Illinois Drainage Code (70 ILCS 605/4-22), a municipality and a
- drainage district may enter into an implementing agreement to
- 13 provide for the automatic detachment of land from the drainage
- 14 <u>district when the land is annexed to the municipality. An</u>
- implementing agreement shall not be required to comply with the
- 16 provisions of Sections 4-19 through 4-24 of the Illinois
- 17 <u>Drainage Code (70 ILCS 605/4-19 through 605/4-24) and may</u>
- 18 authorize the filing of certificates as provided in this
- 19 Section.
- 20 Upon the filing of a certificate, executed by a drainage
- 21 district in compliance with Section 4-11 of the Illinois
- 22 Drainage Code (70 ILCS 605/4-11) and by an annexing
- 23 <u>municipality</u>, the land described in the certificate shall be
- 24 detached from the drainage district and annexed to the annexing
- 25 municipality as of the date of filing. The certificate shall be
- 26 <u>filed with the drainage district clerk and the county clerk</u>
- 27 where the land is located. The legal effect of the filing of a
- certificate shall be the same as a court order entered pursuant
- 29 to Section 8-20 of the Illinois Drainage Code (70 ILCS
- 30 605/8-20).
