 21 buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction of the Office  
 22 of the Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and  
 23 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental  
 24 to the above work:

26 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of this

24 Section 80. The sum of \$250,000, or so much of this  
 25 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
 26 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the  
 27 Penny Severns Summer Family Literacy Grants.

28 Section 85. In addition to any other amounts appropriated  
 29 for such purposes, the sum of \$1,700,000, or so much of this  
 30 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General

1 Revenue Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for a grant  
2 to the Chicago Public Library.

3 Section 90. The sum of \$325,000, or so much of this  
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
5 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all  
6 expenditures and grants to libraries for the Project Next  
7 Generation Program.

8 Section 95. The following amount, or so much of this  
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
10 the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the  
11 purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

12 From Live and Learn Fund .....\$1,750,000

13 Section 100. The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this  
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
15 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund to the Office  
16 of the Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois  
17 Veterans Home libraries.

18 Section 105. The amount of \$65,000, or so much of this  
19 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
20 the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide  
21 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention  
22 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-  
23 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model  
24 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in  
25 Illinois.

26 Section 110. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as  
27 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
28 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants  
29 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American



1 fraternities and sororities.

2 Section 115. The amount of \$21,500, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
4 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants  
5 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School  
6 Programming.

7 Section 120. The amount of \$37,800, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
9 from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide  
10 grants for the development of tourism, education,  
11 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

12 Section 125. The sum of \$70,000, or so much of this  
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police  
14 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of  
15 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for  
16 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial  
17 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children to police  
18 officers killed in the line of duty.

19 Section 130. The sum of \$125,000, or so much of this  
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
21 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for  
22 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer  
23 research, education, screening, and treatment.

24 Section 135. The following amounts, or so much of these  
25 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
26 to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in  
27 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for  
28 grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-  
29 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of

1 organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in  
2 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office  
3 of the Secretary of State:

4 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund .....\$150,000

5 Section 140. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
7 from the Chicago and Northeast Illinois District Council of  
8 Carpenters Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes.

9 Section 145. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as  
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State  
11 from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants  
12 for scholarships for Higher Education.

13 Section 150. The sum of \$90,000, or so much of this  
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Pet  
15 Overpopulation Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State  
16 for grants to humane societies to be used solely for the  
17 humane sterilization of dogs and cats in the State of  
18 Illinois.

19 Section 155. The amount of \$125,000, or so much of this  
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS  
21 Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State  
22 for the cost incident to augmenting the Illinois commercial  
23 motor vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the  
24 identity of drivers, including CDL operators, prior to  
25 licensure.

26 Section 160. The amount of \$657,100, or so much of this  
27 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
28 the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors  
29 Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public

1 awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.

2 Section 165. The amount of \$40,000, or so much of this  
3 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
4 the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence  
5 Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of  
6 persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods  
7 or services related to obtaining evidence.

8 Section 170. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels  
10 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of  
11 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

12 Section 175. The amount of \$11,432,400, or so much of  
13 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
14 Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the  
15 Secretary of State for office automation and technology.

16 Section 180. The amount of \$13,875,000, or so much of  
17 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
18 Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the  
19 Secretary of State for the cost incident to providing new or  
20 replacement plates for motor vehicles.

21 Section 185. The sum of \$1,912,700, or so much of this  
22 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the  
23 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of  
24 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of  
25 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State  
26 and for no other purpose.

27 Section 190. The amount of \$60,000, or so much thereof as  
28 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State

1 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of  
2 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of  
3 alcohol related criminal violence throughout the state.

4 Section 195. The amount of \$60,000 is appropriated from  
5 the Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary  
6 of State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or  
7 contractor or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for  
8 no specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by  
9 the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering  
10 the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of  
11 Police.

12 Section 200. The amount of \$231,300, or so much of this  
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office  
14 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the  
15 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the  
16 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received.

17 Section 205. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this  
18 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
19 the Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to  
20 increase the collection of books, records, and holdings; to  
21 hold public forums; to purchase equipment and resource  
22 materials for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair,  
23 and maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

24 Section 210. The following amount, or so much of this  
25 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of  
26 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,  
27 rehabilitation, new construction, and maintenance of the  
28 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities  
29 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance  
30 security measures in the Capitol Complex:
