SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation Agency for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2005, as follows:

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1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

Section 5. 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25 Section 27. The sum of \$136,147, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 26 business on June 30, 2005, from an appropriation heretofore 27 made for such purpose in Article 33, Section 25 of Public Act 28 93-0842, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites 29 30 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 31 grants for historic preservation programs made either independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 32 or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, or 33

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3 Section 30. The sum of \$89,423, or so much thereof as may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 4 5 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore made in Article 33, Section 30 of Public Act 93-0842, as 6 7 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 8 9 grants for historic preservation programs made either 10 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 11 any or or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 12 private corporation, organization, or individual. 13

The sum of \$1,566, or so much thereof as may 14 Section 35. be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 15 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore 16 made in Article 33, Section 35 of Public Act 93-0842, as 17 18 amended, is reappropriated from the Illinois Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 19 grants for historic preservation programs made either 20 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 21 agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 22 any or or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 23 24 private corporation, organization, or individual.

25 Section 40. The sum of \$23,764, or so much thereof as 26 may be necessary and as remains unexpended at the close of 27 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore 28 made in Article 33, Section 40 of Public Act 93-0842, as 29 amended, is reappropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 30 the Historic Preservation Agency to make Illinois Heritage 31 Grants for the purpose of planning, survey, rehabilitation, 1 restoration, reconstruction, landscaping and acquisition of 2 Illinois properties designated on the National Register of 3 Historic Places or as a landmark based on a county or 4 municipal ordinance or those located within certain historic 5 districts deemed historically significant.

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6 Section 43. The amount of \$0 is appropriated from the 7 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Historic Preservation 8 Agency for a grant for the establishment of a civil rights 9 museum.

10 Section 45. The following named amounts, or so much 11 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated 12 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the 13 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation 14 Agency:

4 Section 50. The sum of \$250,000 or so much thereof as 5 may be necessary is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 6 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the 7 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Administrative 8 Services division for costs associated with but not limited 9 to Union Station, the Old State Capitol and the Old Journal 10 Register Building.

Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Historic Preservation Agency:

20 Section 60. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 22 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for 23 operations, maintenance, repairs, permanent improvements, 24 special events, and all other costs related to the operation 25 of Illinois Historic Sites and only to the extent which 26 donations are received at Illinois State Historic Sites.

27 Section 65. The sum of \$196,300, or so much thereof as 28 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Historic 29 Preservation Agency from the General Revenue Fund for 30 programs and purposes including repairing, maintaining, 31 reconstructing, rehabilitating, replacing, fixed assets, 32 construction and development, studies, all costs for HB2632 -9- OMB094 00110 DLF 30110 b supplies, materials, labor, land acquisition and its related costs, services and other expenses at historic sites.

3 Section 70. The sum of \$236,850, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for the operational 6 expenses of the Lewis and Clark Historic Site in Madison 7 County.

The amounts appropriated for repairs and 8 Section 75. 9 maintenance and other capital improvements in Section 5b of Article for and/or replacements, 10 this repairs and 11 miscellaneous capital improvements at the agency's various historical sites, and are to include 12 construction, improvements, repairs and installation of 13 reconstruction, 14 capital facilities, costs of planning, supplies, materials, and all other types of repairs and maintenance, and capital 15 16 improvements.

17 No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred 18 for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements 19 from appropriations made in Section 5c of this Article until 20 after the purposes and amounts have been approved in writing 21 by the Governor.

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23 Section 80. The sum of \$12,062,200, or so much thereof 24 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Presidential 25 Library and Museum Operating Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency to meet the ordinary and contingent 26 expenses of the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and 27 Museum in Springfield. 28

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30 Section 85. The following named sums, or so much thereof 31 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and 32 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
