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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
7 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of
9 Military Affairs:

21 Section 10. The sum of \$6,750,000, or so much thereof as

22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support

23 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military

24 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to Army

25 National Guard Facilities operations and maintenance as

26 provided for in the Cooperative Funding Agreements, including

27 costs in prior years.

28 Section 15. The sum of \$330,000, or so much thereof as

29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support

30 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military

1 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to the
2 Bartonville and Kankakee armories for operations and
3 maintenance according to the Joint-Use Agreement, including
4 costs in prior years.

5 Section 20. The sum of \$43,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Facilities
8 Division for rehabilitation and minor construction at
9 armories and camps.

10 Section 25. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
12 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant
13 General Division for expenses related to the care and
14 preservation of historic artifacts.

15 Section 30. The sum of \$1,461,200, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs
17 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of
18 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other
19 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be
20 made available from public or private sources.

21 Section 35. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military
23 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs
24 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of
25 grants to persons or families of persons who are members of
26 the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are
27 members of the armed forces of the United States and who have
28 been called to active duty as a result of the September 11,
29 2001 terrorist attacks, including costs in prior years.

1 Section 40. No contract shall be entered into or
2 obligation incurred for any expenditures made from an
3 appropriation herein made in Section 20 until after the
4 purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the
5 Governor.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
7 2005.
