A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
7 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and
8 contingent expenses of the Illinois Violence Prevention
9 Authority:

10 Payable from the Violence Prevention Fund:

30 Section 10. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Violence
2 Prevention Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority
3 for the purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of
4 the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

5 Section 15. The sum of \$2,127,500, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority for the
8 purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of the
9 Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

10 Section 20. The amount of \$849,600, or so much of that
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
12 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority
13 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council
14 Program.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2005.
