1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to
9 the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

2 Section 25. The sum of \$113,200, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
4 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Illinois
5 Workers' Compensation Commission for all costs associated
6 with the establishment and operation of a satellite office in
7 the Metro East area.

9 Section 30. The sum of \$3,800,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
11 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Illinois
12 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with
13 the establishment, administration and operations of the
14 workers' compensation anti-fraud program administered by the
15 Illinois State Police.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
