Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The Illinois Optometric Practice Act of 1987 is 4 5
- amended by changing Section 4 as follows:
- (225 ILCS 80/4) (from Ch. 111, par. 3904) 6
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- Sec. 4. No person shall practice, or attempt to practice, 8
- optometry, as defined in this Act, without a valid license as 9
- an optometrist issued by $\underline{\text{the}}$ $\underline{\text{the}}$ Department. 10
