7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2012)

8 Sec. 2. The ~~The~~ practice of the detection of deception in
9 the State of Illinois is declared to affect the public health,
10 safety and welfare and is subject to regulation and control in
11 the public interest.
