AN ACT concerning business.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Telephone Solicitations Act is amended bychanging Section 20 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 413/20)

7 Sec. 20. Exemptions.

Except as provided in subsection (b), 8 (a) the the provisions of this Act shall not apply to telephone calls made 9 by an autodialer. The provisions of this Act do not apply to 10 11 telephone calls made by a person who is a registered dealer, registered investment adviser, or registered salesperson under 12 13 Section 8 of the Illinois Securities Law of 1953 or who is 14 registered as a broker-dealer, registered representative, or 15 salesperson of a broker-dealer under the federal securities laws, when performing acts within the scope of that 16 17 registration.

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), all telephone calls must be made in compliance with the requirements of subsection (c) of Section 15. (Source: P.A. 91-182, eff. 1-1-00.)
