Amends the Good Samaritan Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning immunity from civil liability for giving or receiving and acting on emergency telephone instructions.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (745 ILCS 49/5)
- Sec. 5. Emergency telephone instructions; exemption from civil liability. No person who gives emergency instructions
- 9 through a system established under the the Emergency Telephone
- 10 System Act to persons rendering services in an emergency at
- 11 another location, nor any person following the instructions in
- 12 rendering the services, shall be liable for any civil damages
- as a result of issuing or following the instructions, unless
- issuing or following the instructions constitutes willful or
- 15 wanton misconduct.
