1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that  
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
6 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services to conduct a  
7 best practices study for the treatment of methamphetamine  
8 users and addicts and to prepare a report of the Department's  
9 findings for the General Assembly and the public.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
11 2005.
