1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services to conduct a best practices study for the treatment of methamphetamine users and addicts and to prepare a report of the Department's findings for the General Assembly and the public.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
