SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$250,000 for FY06 to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor to conduct education seminars for prosecutors throughout the State on how to prosecute cases in drug court with a specific emphasis on cases involving the illegal possession of methamphetamine. Effective July 1, 2005.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$250,000, or so much of that 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General 6 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate 7 Prosecutor to conduct education seminars for prosecutors 8 throughout the State on how to prosecute cases in drug court 9 with a specific emphasis on cases involving the illegal 10 possession of methamphetamine.
