The Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall conduct education seminars for prosecutors throughout the State on how to prosecute cases in drug court with a specific emphasis on cases involving the illegal possession of methamphetamine.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July1, 2005.
