Appropriates \$400,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Agriculture to conduct a public information campaign for farmers on the protocols to be followed when a farmer encounters a site in which methamphetamine is being manufactured. Effective July 1, 2005.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$400,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Agriculture to conduct a public information campaign for farmers on the protocols to be followed when a farmer encounters a site in which methamphetamine is being manufactured.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
