SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 205/205-16 new

Amends the Department of Agriculture Law. Provides that the Department of Agriculture shall conduct a public information campaign for farmers on the protocols to be followed when a farmer encounters a suspected site in which methamphetamine is being manufactured. Effective July 1, 2005.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Agriculture Law of the Civil
Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section
205-16 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 205/205-16 new)
8 <u>Sec. 205-16. Public information to farmers on encountering</u>
9 <u>methamphetamine manufacturing sites. The Department of</u>
10 <u>Agriculture shall conduct a public information campaign for</u>
11 <u>farmers on the protocols to be followed when a farmer</u>
12 <u>encounters a suspected site in which methamphetamine is being</u>
13 <u>manufactured.</u>

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 15 1, 2005.
