8 <u>(a) The Department of Children and Family Services, the</u> 9 <u>Department of State Police, and the State Board of Education</u> 10 <u>shall jointly develop a sample protocol to be followed by the</u> 11 <u>Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of</u> 12 <u>State Police or a local law enforcement agency, or a school</u> 13 <u>when:</u>

14(1) a person or persons are arrested for manufacturing15methamphetamine at a place where a child under 18 years of16age resides; or
