SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 725/3.4

from Ch. 85, par. 2557

Amends the Uniform Peace Officers' Disciplinary Act. Requires advance written notice of the name, rank, and unit of command of all persons who will be present on behalf of the employer during the interrogation of a peace officer.

1 AN ACT concerning peace officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Uniform Peace Officers' Disciplinary Act is amended by changing Section 3.4 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 725/3.4) (from Ch. 85, par. 2557)
- 7 Sec. 3.4. <u>Notice.</u> The officer under investigation shall be
- 8 informed <u>in writing</u> of the name, rank and unit or command of
- 9 the officer in charge of the investigation, the interrogators,
- and all persons who will be present on behalf of the employer
- 11 during any interrogation $\underline{}$ except at a public administrative
- 12 proceeding.
