Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

14	the State Appellate Defender for expenses related to
15	federally assisted programs to work on systematic sentencing
16	issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed, to
17	provide statewide training and services to Illinois Public
18	Defenders, and to enhance the capability of public defenders
19	in rural counties to effectively represent their clients in
20	appropriate cases, making available expert witnesses and
21	investigative services to them:

27	Section 20. The amount of \$3,198,155, or so much thereof
28	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
29	Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate
30	Defender for expenses incurred in providing assistance to
31	trial attorneys under subdivision (c)(5) of Section 10 of the
32	State Appellate Defender Act.

- 1 Section 25. The amount of \$284,985, or so much thereof
- 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
- 3 Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for
- 4 expenses incurred to operate the Expungement Information
- 5 Program.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 7 2005.
