- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Sections
 4-105, 5-105, and 6-105 as follows:

7 Sec. 4-105. Election day registration. Notwithstanding any 8 other provision of this Code to the contrary, beginning January 1, 2007, an election authority may accept the in-person 9 registration of voters on the day of the consolidated primary 10 election and the day of the consolidated election. Each 11 election authority that permits the registration authorized by 12 this Section shall provide by rule for the implementation of 13 14 this Section.
