SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

P.A. 93-842, Art. 54, Sec. 280

Amends Public Act 93-842, "AN ACT making appropriations".
Appropriates \$197,000,000 (instead of \$173,000,000) from the
USDA Women, Infants and Children Fund to the Department of
Human Services for grants for free distribution of food under
the WIC program. Effective immediately.
