## State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 HB4143

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$4,500,000 from the General Revenue Fund as follows: (1) \$3,000,000 to the Early Intervention Services Revolving Fund for a 3% cost-of-doing-business increase for physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, developmental therapy, and service coordination at the Department of Human Services for payment for early intervention services; and (2) \$1,500,000 to the Department of Healthcare and Family Services, for a 3% cost-of-doing-business increase for providers of each of the following services in connection with the provision of therapy services: physical therapy, speech therapy, and occupational therapy funded by the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Effective January 1, 2006.

BALANCED BUDGET NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. In addition to any other amounts heretofore appropriated for these purposes, the sum of \$4,500,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund as follows:
- 8 (1) \$3,000,000 to the Early Intervention Services
  9 Revolving Fund for a 3% cost-of-doing-business increase for
  10 physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy,
  11 developmental therapy, and service coordination at the
  12 Department of Human Services for payment for early
  13 intervention services.
- (2) \$1,500,000 to the Department of Healthcare and Family
  Services, for a 3% cost-of-doing-business increase for
  providers of each of the following services in connection
  with the provision of therapy services: physical therapy,
  speech therapy, and occupational therapy funded by the
  Department of Healthcare and Family Services.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 21 1, 2006.
