Amends the Animal Control Act. Authorizes municipalities and other political subdivisions to ban specified dog breeds and to regulate dogs by breed. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing Sections 2 and 24 and by adding Section 2.20 as follows:
(510 ILCS 5/2) (from Ch. 8, par. 352)
Sec. 2. Definitions. As used in this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the terms specified in the following Sections \(Z .01\) though 2.19 have the meanings ascribed to them in those Sections. (Source: P.A. 78-795.)
(510 ILCS 5/2.20 new)
Sec. 2.20. Scheduled dog breed. "Scheduled dog breed" means American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, pit bull, pit bull terrier, rottweiler, and Staffordshire Terrier.
```

(510 ILCS 5/24) (from Ch. 8, par. 374)
Sec. 24. Nothing in this Act shall be held to limit in any manner the power of any municipality or other political subdivision to prohibit animals from running at large, nor shall anything in this Act be construed to, in any manner, limit the power of any municipality or other political subdivision to further control and regulate dogs, cats or other animals in such municipality or other political subdivision. With respect to dogs, regulations and ordinances (i) may ban one or more scheduled dog breeds and (ii) may be prod that no regulation or ordinance is specific to breed. Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
