AN ACT concerning animals.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing 5 Sections 2 and 24 and by adding Section 2.20 as follows:

Sec. 2. <u>Definitions.</u> As used in this Act, unless the
context otherwise requires, the terms specified in <u>the</u>
<u>following</u> Sections 2.01 through 2.19 have the meanings ascribed
to them in those Sections.

<u>Sec. 2.20. Scheduled dog breed. "Scheduled dog breed" means</u>
 <u>American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, pit</u>
 <u>bull, pit bull terrier, rottweiler, and Staffordshire Terrier.</u>

17 Sec. 24. Nothing in this Act shall be held to limit in any manner the power of any municipality or other political 18 subdivision to prohibit animals from running at large, nor 19 20 shall anything in this Act be construed to, in any manner, 21 limit the power of any municipality or other political subdivision to further control and regulate dogs, cats or other 22 23 animals in such municipality or other political subdivision. 24 With respect to dogs, regulations and ordinances (i) may ban one or more scheduled dog breeds and (ii) may be provided that 25 26 no regulation or ordinance is specific to breed.
