

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 HB4397

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 605/605-955 new

Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that, subject to appropriation, the Department shall establish and administer a guardsman and reservist homebuyer assistance program. Authorizes an eligible applicant of the program to apply to the Department for financial assistance for a portion of the down payment on the purchase of a house. Provides that the financial assistance shall not exceed 10% of the purchase price of the house and shall be in the form of a grant and that an eligible applicant may apply for financial assistance up to 3 years following the completion of active duty. Defines "eligible applicant". Authorizes the Department to adopt necessary rules for the program. Effective July 1, 2006

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
- 6 amended by adding Section 605-955 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 605/605-955 new)
- 8 Sec. 605-955. National Guard and Reservist homebuyer
- 9 assistance.
- 10 (a) Subject to appropriation, the Department shall
- 11 <u>establish and administer a guardsman and reservist homebuyer</u>
- 12 <u>assistance program. Under the program, an eligible applicant</u>
- 13 may apply to the Department for financial assistance for a
- 14 portion of the down payment on the purchase of a house. The
- financial assistance shall not exceed 10% of the purchase price
- of the house and shall be in the form of a grant to the approved
- 17 <u>eligible applicant. An eligible applicant may apply for</u>
- financial assistance up to 3 years following the completion of
- 19 active duty.
- 20 <u>(b) As used in this Section</u>, "eliqible applicant" means a
- 21 member of the Illinois National Guard or the reserves of the
- 22 Armed Forces of the United State called to active duty after
- 23 <u>September 11, 2001.</u>
- 24 (c) The Department shall adopt necessary rules for the
- 25 <u>implementation of this Section</u>, including rules for the
- 26 <u>solicitation</u>, collection, and approval of applications and for
- 27 the distribution of program grants.
- 28 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 29 2006.
