AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4449

AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4449 on page 1, immediately above line 4, by inserting the following:

"Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Internet Caller Identification Act.

Section 5. Definition. As used in this Act:

"Caller identification" means the display of the caller's telephone number or identity to the recipient of the call.

Section 10. Internet caller identification. No person shall use any Internet caller identification equipment or Internet phone equipment in such a manner as to make a number or name, other than the caller's residential or business phone number or the caller's legal or business name, appear on a caller identification system of the recipient of the call.

Section 15. Violations. Whenever any person knowingly uses or has knowingly used any Internet caller identification equipment or Internet phone equipment in violation of this Act, that use shall be deemed an unlawful act or practice under the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. In the case of the use of Internet caller identification or Internet phone equipment in violation of this Act, all remedies, penalties, and authority available to the Attorney General and
