AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Naprapathic Practice Act is amended by 5 changing Section 33 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 63/33)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2013)

Sec. 33. Records of examinations and treatments. Every 8 licensed naprapath shall keep a record of naprapathic 9 examinations and and treatments made that shall include the 10 names of persons examined and treated. The record shall be 11 signed by the licensed naprapath and retained by him or her in 12 13 the office in which the professional service was rendered. The 14 records shall be preserved by the naprapath for a period of 3 15 years from the date on which the professional service was rendered. A copy of the records shall be provided, upon written 16 17 request, to the person examined and treated or his or her 18 designee.
