Amends the Medical Practice Act of 1987. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the duties of the Department.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Medical Practice Act of 1987 is amended by
- 5 changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 60/10) (from Ch. 111, par. 4400-10)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- 8 Sec. 10. The Department shall:
- 9 (A) Make rules for establishing reasonable minimum 10 standards of educational requirements to be observed by 11 medical, osteopathic <u>and and chiropractic colleges;</u>
- (B) Effectuate the policy of the State of Illinois that the quality of medical training is an appropriate concern in the recruiting, licensing, credentialing and participation in residency programs of physicians. However, it is inappropriate to discriminate against any physician because of national origin or geographic location of medical education;
- 18 (C) Formulate rules and regulations required for the administration of this Act.
