Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Optometric Practice Act of 1987 is
- 5 amended by changing Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 80/4) (from Ch. 111, par. 3904)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)
- 8 Sec. 4. No person shall practice, or attempt to practice,
- 9 optometry, as defined in this Act, without a valid license as
- 10 an optometrist issued by $\underline{\text{the}}$ Department.
