AN ACT concerning property.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Conveyances Act is amended by changing
Section 35c as follows:

6 (765 ILCS 5/35c) (from Ch. 30, par. 34c)

7 Sec. 35c. Whenever any deed or instrument of conveyance or other instrument to be made a matter of record is executed 8 there shall be typed or printed to the side or below all 9 10 signatures the names of the parties signing such instruments including the witnesses thereto, if any, and the names of the 11 parties or officers taking the acknowledgments. The absence or 12 neglect to print or type the names of the parties under the 13 14 signatures shall not invalidate the instrument.

15 <u>Whenever any deed or instrument of conveyance or other</u> 16 <u>instrument to be made a matter of record is executed, the</u> 17 <u>signatures of the parties making the conveyance shall be</u> 18 <u>acknowledged by a notary public appointed and commissioned by</u> 19 <u>the Secretary of State or by one of the courts or officers</u> 20 <u>designated in Section 20 of this Act. Failure to comply with</u> 21 <u>this provision shall not invalidate the instrument.</u>

Whenever any deed or instrument of conveyance is executed the name and address of the owner or owners to whom subsequent tax bills are to be sent shall be endorsed on the instrument. The absence or neglect of any one to comply with this provision shall not invalidate the instrument.

27 Whenever any deed or instrument of conveyance is executed 28 and is to be made a matter of record wherein a metes and bounds 29 description is incorporated, the metes and bounds description 30 shall contain the section, township and range with an 31 identifiable point of beginning. Subsequent courses shall 32 contain approximate linear distance and direction values, HB4760 Enrolled

1 direction being defined as any one or more of the following:

a. The angular relationship of the described course to adescribed course.

4 b. The bearing of the described course relative to the5 bearing of a described course.

c. The relationship of the described course to a known
line, or a point thereon, such as a previously described course
in the same description or a line of a section or fraction
thereof or a line in a platted lot or block.

10 If references are made to existing monuments or points or 11 lines of previously recorded conveyances, the instant 12 description shall contain sufficient information so that it may 13 be located without reference to matters outside the instant 14 description.

15 The neglect to comply with the provisions of this Section 16 shall not invalidate the instrument.
