## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 45/6

from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1306

Amends the Lead Poisoning Prevention Act. Requires any person selling paint or paint removal supplies to post a notice (i) warning of the dangers of lead-based paint dust and (ii) informing of the importance of lead-safe work practices. Requires the notice to provide telephone numbers to call for more information. Requires the Department of Public Health to adopt rules establishing the information to be contained in the notices.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Lead Poisoning Prevention Act is amended by
changing Section 6 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 45/6) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1306)

7 Sec. 6. Warning statement. No person, firm, or corporation shall have, offer for sale, sell, or give away any lead bearing 8 substance that may be used by the general public unless it 9 federal bears the warning statement prescribed by 10 as regulation. If no regulation is prescribed the warning 11 statement shall be as follows: "WARNING--CONTAINS LEAD. DRIED 12 FILM OF THIS SUBSTANCE MAY BE HARMFUL IF EATEN OR CHEWED. See 13 14 Other Cautions on (Side or Back) Panel. Do not apply on toys, 15 or other children's articles, furniture, or interior, or exterior exposed surfaces of any residential building or 16 17 facility that may be occupied or used by children. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN." 18

(a) The generic term of a product, such as "paint" may besubstituted for the word "substance" in the above labeling.

(b) The placement, conspicuousness, and contrast of the above labeling shall be in accordance with Section 191.101 of the regulations promulgated under the provisions of the Federal Hazardous Substances Act.

(c) Any person selling paint or paint removal supplies in this State shall post a notice (i) warning of the dangers of lead-based paint dust and (ii) informing of the importance of lead-safe work practices. Notices posted pursuant to this subsection (c) shall contain telephone numbers of federal and State agencies that consumers can call for more information.
