Amend House Bill 4900 on page 1 by 3 replacing line 8 with the following: "(a) Subject to the limitations set forth in this Section, 4 5 the"; and on page 1, by replacing line 21 with the following: 6 7 "(b) Whenever any such park district, city, village, or"; and 9 on page 2, be replacing lines 19 and 20 with the following: "(c) A park district, city, village, or incorporated town 10 may provide that a higher fine shall be imposed for a speeding 11 12 violation that occurs on a residential collector street. The 13 fine for any one speeding violation may not, however, exceed 14 \$500. As used in this Section, a "residential collector street" 15 is a street identified by the official street map as having the 16 primary function of collecting traffic from local residence 17 district streets and connecting traffic to other collector and 18 19 arterial streets. (d) A limit so determined and declared by a park district, 20 city, village, or incorporated town <u>under subsection</u> (b) 21 22 becomes effective, and"; and

on page 3, line 4, by replacing "Whenever" with "(e) Whenever".
