

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 HB4926

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/5

from Ch. 38, par. 83-5

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that if a person has been issued a Firearm Owner's Identification Card that has expired, possession of the expired Firearm Owner's Identification Card with proof that the person has made an application for renewal of the Firearm Owner's Identification Card shall be considered proof that the person possesses a valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning firearms.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/5) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-5)

7 Sec. 5. The Department of State Police shall either approve or deny all applications within 30 days from the date they are 8 received, and every applicant found qualified pursuant to 9 10 Section 8 of this Act by the Department shall be entitled to a Firearm Owner's Identification Card upon the payment of a \$5 11 fee. \$3 of each fee derived from the issuance of Firearm 12 Owner's Identification Cards, or renewals thereof, shall be 13 deposited in the Wildlife and Fish Fund in the State Treasury; 14 15 \$1 of such fee shall be deposited in the State Police Services Fund and \$1 of such fee shall be deposited in the Firearm 16 17 Owner's Notification Fund. Monies in the Firearm Owner's 18 Notification Fund shall be used exclusively to pay for the cost of 19 sending notices expiration of Firearm 20 Identification Cards under Section 13.2 of this Act. Excess monies in the Firearm Owner's Notification Fund shall be used 21 22 to ensure the prompt and efficient processing of applications 23 received under Section 4 of this Act. If a person has been issued a Firearm Owner's Identification Card that has expired, 24 possession of the expired Firearm Owner's Identification Card 25 26 with proof that the person has made an application for renewal of the Firearm Owner's Identification Card shall be considered 27 proof that the person possesses a valid Firearm Owner's 28 Identification Card. 29
