1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-5e as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-5e new)

7 Sec. 5-5e. Waiver for home and community-based services for children with developmental disabilities or autism spectrum 8 disorder. The Department of Healthcare and Family Services 9 shall apply for a waiver or waivers from the United States 10 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services pursuant to Section 11 1915(c) of the Social Security Act no later than June 1, 2006, 12 or as soon thereafter as practicable, to allow payment for 13 in-home and community-based treatment, therapies, training 14 15 including parent training, and other necessary aids and services for children from the age of 3 up to the age of 21 who 16 are diagnosed with a developmental disability or autism 17 spectrum disorder, including those children whose families 18 19 would not otherwise qualify for medical assistance under this Article due to family income or assets. The application or 20 21 applications shall request an implementation date of January 1, 2007, or as soon thereafter as may be approved by the United 22 States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, and shall 23 provide for: (i) a minimum of 800 children in the first year of 24 implementation, of which no fewer than 500 shall be children 25 26 with autism spectrum disorder; (ii) a minimum of 1,750 children in the second year of implementation, of which no fewer than 27 28 1,000 shall be children with autism spectrum disorder; and (iii) a minimum of 3,350 in the third and subsequent years of 29 30 implementation, of which 2,000 shall be children with autism spectrum disorder. 31
