AN ACT concerning health.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental 5 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 1-106 as 6 follows:

7 (405 ILCS 5/1-106) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 1-106)

Sec. 1-106. "Developmental disability" means a disability 8 which is attributable to: (a) mental retardation, cerebral 9 palsy, epilepsy or autism; or to (b) any other condition which 10 11 results in impairment similar to that caused by mental retardation and and which requires services similar to those 12 required by mentally retarded persons. Such disability must 13 originate before the age of 18 years, be expected to continue 14 15 indefinitely, and constitute a substantial handicap.
