Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 15. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Historic 12 Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and 13 grants for historic preservation programs made either 14 independently or in cooperation with the Federal Government 15 any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 16 or or 17 political subdivision of the State, or with any public or private corporation, organization, or individual. 18

Section 20. The sum of \$295,500, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 20 business on June 30, 2006, from an appropriation heretofore 21 made for such purpose in Article 61, Sections 25, 27, 30, and 22 23 35 of Public Act 94-15, is reappropriated from the Illinois 24 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and grants for historic preservation programs made 25 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal 26 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 27 or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 28 29 private corporation, organization, or individual.
