1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1 4 Section 5. - Section 10. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred 1 2 State Employees' Retirement System pursuant the continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions 3 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State 5 6 Employees' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance", 7 approved June 10, 1919, as amended.
- The sum of \$35,236,800, or so much thereof 9 Section 15. 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement 11 12 System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.
- Section 20. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred 13 14 to the Judges' Retirement System pursuant to continuing appropriation authorized by the 15 State Pensions 16 Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' 17 18 Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance", approved June 10, 19 1919, as amended. 20
- Section 25. The sum of \$5,220,300, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 22 23 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly Retirement System for the State's Contribution, as provided 24 by law. 25
- Section 30. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred 26 27 the General Assembly Retirement System pursuant continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions 28 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the 29 30 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General
