# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 3 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund to the Office 4 of the Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois 5 Veterans Home libraries.

Section 105. The amount of \$50,000, or so much of this 6 7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide 8 9 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-10 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model 11 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in 12 Illinois. 13

Section 110. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American fraternities and sororities.

Section 115. The amount of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School Programming.

Section 120. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide grants for the development of tourism, education, preservation and promotion of Route 66. -16- LRB094 18175 RCE 55403 b

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1 Section 125. The sum of \$75,000, or so much of this 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police 3 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of 4 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for 5 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial 6 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children to police 7 officers killed in the line of duty.

8 Section 130. The sum of \$110,000, or so much of this 9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 10 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for 11 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer 12 research, education, screening, and treatment.

13 Section 135. The following amounts, or so much of these 14 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in 15 16 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-17 18 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in 19 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office 20 of the Secretary of State: 21

23 Section 140. The amount of \$500, or so much thereof as 24 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State 25 from the Chicago and Northeast Illinois District Council of 26 Carpenters Fund to provide grants for charitable purposes.

27 Section 145. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as 28 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State 29 from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants 30 for scholarships for Higher Education. -17- LRB094 18175 RCE 55403 b

Section 155. The amount of \$546,000, or so much of this 1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS 2 Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State 3 for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the 4 5 cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity 6 of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for 7 improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal 8 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed 9 10 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

Section 160. The amount of \$333,500, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.

Section 165. The amount of \$50,000, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods or services related to obtaining evidence.

22 Section 170. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof 23 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels 24 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of 25 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

Section 175. The amount of \$14,149,800, or so much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for office automation and technology. -18- LRB094 18175 RCE 55403 b

1 Section 180. The amount of \$13,875,000, or so much of 2 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 3 Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the 4 Secretary of State for the cost incident to providing new or 5 replacement plates for motor vehicles.

6 Section 185. The sum of \$2,090,000, or so much of this 7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the 8 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of 9 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of 10 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State 11 and for no other purpose.

Section 190. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of goods and services that will assist in the prevention of alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

Section 195. The amount of \$70,000 is appropriated from 17 the Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary 18 State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or 19 of contractor or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for 20 21 no specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by 22 the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of 23 Police. 24

25 Section 200. The amount of \$700,000, or so much of this 26 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office 27 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the 28 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the 29 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received. -19- LRB094 18175 RCE 55403 b

1 Section 205. The amount of \$12,000, or so much of this 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 3 the Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to 4 increase the collection of books, records, and holdings; to 5 hold public forums; to purchase equipment and resource 6 materials for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair, 7 and maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

8 Section 210. The following amount, or so much of this 9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of 10 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations, 11 rehabilitation, new construction, and maintenance of the 12 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities 13 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance 14 security measures in the Capitol Complex:

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2006.

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
