A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet  
9 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending  
10 June 30, 2007:

11	For Personal Services .....	2,100,100
12	For State Contributions to Social	
13	Security, for Medicare .....	28,000
14	For Contractual Services .....	568,500
15	For Travel .....	54,400
16	For Commodities .....	11,800
17	For Printing .....	10,900
18	For Equipment .....	16,500
19	For Telecommunications .....	41,900
20	For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....	<u>3,200</u>
21	Total	\$2,835,300

22 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much  
23 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the  
24 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for  
25 distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education  
26 Cooperation Act:

28 Section 15. The following named amount, or so much  
29 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General

1 Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for  
2 distribution as grants authorized by the Higher Education  
3 Cooperation Act:

4 Access and Diversity .....4,787,300

5 Section 20. The sum of \$2,652,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the  
8 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for  
9 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

10 Section 25. The sum of \$9,500,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
13 incentive grants to Illinois higher education institutions in  
14 the competition for external grants and contracts.

15 Section 30. The sum of \$17,000,000, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
17 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
18 grants authorized by the Health Services Education Grants  
19 Act.

20 Section 35. The sum of \$2,750,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
22 Fund to the Department of Public Health for distribution of  
23 medical education scholarships authorized by an Act to  
24 provide grants for family practice residency programs and  
25 medical student scholarships through the Illinois Department  
26 of Public Health.

27 Section 40. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as  
28 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants  
29 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under

1 the terms and conditions associated with the federal  
2 contracts and grants moneys received.

3 Section 45. The sum of \$2,800,000, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
5 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration  
6 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying  
7 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

8 Section 50. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
10 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as  
11 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of  
12 higher education.

13 Section 55. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants  
16 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating  
17 nurses.

18 Section 60. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as  
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
20 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator  
21 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

22 Section 65. The sum of \$147,700, or so much thereof may  
23 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
24 to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses  
25 related to or in support of a higher education shared  
26 services center.

27 Section 70. The following named amounts, or so much  
28 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects

1 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
 2 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science  
 3 Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the  
 4 fiscal year ending June 30, 2007:

8	For Contractual Services .....	4,210,500

16 Section 75. The following named amounts, or so much  
 17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
 18 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
 19 Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy Income Fund to the  
 20 Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to meet ordinary and  
 21 contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006:

23	For State Contributions to Social	
24	Security, for Medicare .....	27,400
25	For Contractual Services .....	981,100
26	For Travel .....	126,700
27	For Commodities .....	143,200

1           Section 80. The sum of \$450,000, or so much thereof as  
2    may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3    Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy for the  
4    Excellence 2000 Program in Mathematics and Science.

5           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
6    2006.
