A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the  
7 objects and purposes named, to meet the ordinary and  
8 contingent expenses of the Illinois Violence Prevention  
9 Authority:

10 Payable from the Violence Prevention Fund:

11	For Personal Services .....	501,600
12	For State Contributions to State	
13	Employees' Retirement System .....	57,700
14	For State Contribution to	
15	Social Security .....	38,400
16	For Group Insurance .....	116,000
17	For Contractual Services .....	43,000

28 Section 10. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as  
29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Violence  
30 Prevention Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority

1 for the purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of  
2 the Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

3 Section 15. The sum of \$2,127,500, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
5 Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority for the  
6 purpose of awarding grants under the provisions of the  
7 Violence Prevention Act of 1995.

8 Section 20. The amount of \$849,600, or so much of that  
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
10 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority  
11 for the Illinois Family Violence Coordinating Council  
12 Program.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
14 2006.
