A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
8 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

16 Section 10. The sum of \$627,815, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
18 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and
19 expenses related to or in support of a public safety shared
20 services center.

21 Section 15. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
23 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
24 administrative expenses of the Elevator Safety and Regulation
25 Act.

26 Section 20. The sum of \$185,000, or so much thereof as
27 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
28 Firefighters' Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire
29 Marshal for expenses related to the maintenance of the
30 Illinois Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen
31 Firefighter Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under

1 Public Act 91-0832.

2 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
4 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

8 Section 35. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
10 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
11 for the development of new fire districts.

12 Section 40. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
14 Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
15 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs
16 incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
17 Program.

18 Section 45. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
20 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
21 available for the development of local government fire
22 prevention.

23 Section 50. The sum of \$714,200, or so much thereof as
24 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
25 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
26 available for the NITE project.

27 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
28 2006.
