Makes appropriations to the Attorney General and the Sex Offender Management Board from named funds for various expenses. Effective July 1, 2006.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

27	Section 10. The sum of \$1,175,000, or so much thereof as
28	is available for use by the Attorney General, is appropriated
29	to the Attorney General from the Illinois Gaming Law
30	Enforcement Fund for State law enforcement purposes.

1	Section 15. The following named sums, or so much thereof
2	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
3	Asbestos Abatement Fund to the Attorney General to meet the
4	ordinary and contingent expenses of the Environmental
5	Enforcement-Asbestos Litigation Division:

19	Section 20. The amount of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof
20	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
21	General Court Ordered and Voluntary Compliance Payment
22	Projects Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for use,
23	subject to pertinent court order or agreement, in the
24	performance of any function pertaining to the exercise of the
25	duties of the Attorney General, including State law
26	enforcement and public education.
27	Section 25. The amount of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof
28	as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
29	Charity Bureau Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to
30	enforce the provisions of the Solicitation for Charity Act
31	and to gather and disseminate information about charitable
32	trustees and organizations to the public.

- 1 Section 30. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof
- 2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
- 3 General Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the
- 4 Office of the Attorney General for State law enforcement
- 5 purposes.
- 6 Section 35. The amount of \$900,000, or so much thereof
- 7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
- 8 Litigation Trust Fund to the Attorney General for financial
- 9 support under the Capital Crimes Litigation Act.
- 10 Section 40. The amount of \$870,000, or so much thereof
- 11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco
- 12 Settlement Recovery Fund to the Attorney General for the
- 13 funding of a unit responsible for oversight, enforcement, and
- 14 implementation of the Master Settlement Agreement entered in
- the case of People of the State of Illinois v. Philip Morris,
- 16 et al. (Circuit Court of Cook County, No. 96L13146), for
- 17 enforcement of the Tobacco Product Manufacturers' Escrow Act,
- 18 and for handling remaining tobacco-related litigation.
- 19 Section 45. The amount of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof
- 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney
- 21 General's State Projects and Court Ordered Distribution Fund
- 22 to the Attorney General for payment of interagency
- 23 agreements, for court-ordered distributions to third parties,
- 24 and, subject to pertinent court order, for performance of any
- 25 function pertaining to the exercise of the duties of the
- 26 Attorney General, including State law enforcement and public
- 27 education.
- Section 50. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
- 29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General's

- 1 Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General to be
- 2 expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
- 3 which those funds were received.
- 4 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
- and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the
- 7 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses
- 8 of the Attorney General:

- 10 Payable from the Violent Crime Victims Assistance Fund:
- 12 For State Contribution to State Employees'
- 13 Retirement System ......90,800
- 14 For State Contribution to Social Security ...........60,300

- 24 Total \$9,903,000
- 25 Section 60. The amount of \$280,000, or so much thereof
- 26 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Child Support
- 27 Administrative Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for
- 28 child support enforcement purposes.
- 29 Section 65. The amount of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 30 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Attorney General
- 31 Federal Grant Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for

1 funding for federal grants.

- The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof 2 Section 70. as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sex Offender 3 Management Board Fund to the Sex Offender Management Board 4 for the purposes authorized by the Sex Offender Management 5 including, but not limited to, sex offender 6 Board Act evaluation, treatment, and monitoring programs and grants. 7 Funding received from private sources is to be expended in 8 accordance with the terms and conditions placed upon the 9 10 funding.
- Section 75. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide Grand Jury Prosecution Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for expenses incurred in criminal prosecutions arising under the Statewide Grand Jury Act.
- Section 80. The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for costs related to the Illinois Equal Justice Act.
- Section 85. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may 20 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 21 22 Office of the Attorney General for improvements including, but not limited to, construction, 23 reconstruction, improvement, repair, and installation of 24 capital facilities, cost of planning, supplies, materials, 25 equipment, services, and all other expenses required for its 26 27 Springfield office at 500 S. Second Street.

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Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2006.
