SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/12-3.4 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of domestic assault when a person knowingly or intentionally engages in conduct that places a family or household member in reasonable apprehension of receiving a battery. Requires a peace officer to arrest the offender upon the establishment of probable cause. Makes the offense a Class A misdemeanor.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
Section 12-3.4 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/12-3.4 new)

7 <u>Sec. 12-3.4.</u> Domestic assault.

(a) A person commits domestic assault when, without lawful 8 authority, he or she knowingly or intentionally engages in 9 conduct that places a family or household member, as defined in 10 subsection (3) of Section 112A-3 of the Code of Criminal 11 Procedure of 1963, in reasonable apprehension of receiving a 12 battery. A peace officer must arrest the offender upon the 13 establishment of probable cause. 14 (b) Sentence. Domestic assault is a Class A misdemeanor. 15
