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HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The provision of a free appropriate public 3 education (FAPE) for a student with hearing loss can only occur 4 with full communication access to education; and

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WHEREAS, Full communication access 5 depends upon environment that fosters 6 language-rich age-appropriate development, 7 language and language-proficient educational staff, and provides for direct 8 9 communication with staff and peers; and

WHEREAS, Children and youth who are deaf or hard of hearing face unique and significant barriers related to language and communication that profoundly affect most aspects of the educational process; and

WHEREAS, Attending to a student's communication needs and language development is a vital prerequisite for access to educational opportunities that lead to literacy and academic achievement; therefore, be it

- 24 child's most basic of needs; ensure communication-driven

RESOLVED, That the Task Force, working with the Illinois 2 3 Deaf and Hard of Hearing Commission, the Illinois State Board 4 of Education, the Early Intervention System, the Illinois School for the Deaf, and the Newborn Hearing Screening Program, 5 shall assist those entities in developing interagency 6 7 agreements and programs and procedures regarding universal, 8 early identification of hearing loss and effective interface between medical and educational services; and be it further 9

10 RESOLVED, That the Task Force may request assistance from 11 any entity necessary or useful for the performance of its 12 duties; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall issue a report with its 14 recommendations to the General Assembly on or before January 1, 15 2007.
