SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 5

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that the Governor must have the written consent of all 4 legislative leaders to call a special session of the General Assembly and must have the written consent of the President and Minority Leader of the Senate to call a special session of the Senate. Effective upon being declared adopted.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF TH
NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, TH
SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to th
electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the genera
election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption o
this resolution a proposition to amend Section 5 of Article I
of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

10 ARTICLE IV

THE LEGISLATURE

- 12 (ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 5)
- 13 SECTION 5. SESSIONS
 - (a) The General Assembly shall convene each year on the second Wednesday of January. The General Assembly shall be a continuous body during the term for which members of the House of Representatives are elected.
- (b) The Governor may convene the General Assembly, with the 18 written consent of the President of the Senate, the Speaker of 19 20 the House of Representatives, the Minority Leader of the Senate, and the Minority Leader of the House of 21 Representatives, or the Senate alone, with the written consent 22 23 of the President of the Senate and the Minority Leader of the 24 Senate, in special session by a proclamation stating the 25 purpose of the session; and only business encompassed by such purpose, together with any impeachments or confirmation of 26 27 appointments shall be transacted. Special sessions of the General Assembly may also be convened by joint proclamation of 28 the presiding officers of both houses, issued as provided by 29 law. 30
- 31 (c) Sessions of each house of the General Assembly and 32 meetings of committees, joint committees and legislative 33 commissions shall be open to the public. Sessions and committee

- 1 meetings of a house may be closed to the public if two-thirds
- of the members elected to that house determine that the public
- 3 interest so requires; and meetings of joint committees and
- 4 legislative commissions may be so closed if two-thirds of the
- 5 members elected to each house so determine.
